

Jackie and Shadow

Jackie (<u>c.</u> 2012) and **Shadow** (<u>c.</u> 2014) are a wild female and male <u>bald eagle</u> couple who reside near <u>Big</u> <u>Bear Lake</u> in <u>San Bernardino County</u>, <u>California</u>. Their attempts to hatch and raise offspring have been live-streamed by Friends of Big Bear Valley since 2018.

History

Bald eagles from points farther north, such as <u>Idaho</u> or <u>Canada</u>, migrate to <u>Big Bear Valley</u>, but most do not stay year-round. <u>San Bernardino National Forest</u> rangers discovered in 2012 that this area had become nesting territory for eagles. <u>Jackie and Shadow are the only bald eagle current year-round residents at Big Bear Lake. <u>Il</u></u>

Jackie, believed to be the first eaglet hatched in Big Bear Valley, [3] came to the public's attention in 2017, when she and her mate took over an abandoned nest beside a live-stream camera installed by <u>Friends of Big Bear Valley</u>. [4] Shadow came to the public's attention one year later, when he replaced Jackie's mate at that nest. [5] The nest itself is 145 feet (44 m) above ground in a <u>Jeffrey pine</u> in the National Forest near <u>Fawnskin</u>. [6] As the tree is near a parking lot, picnic area, and campsite, the <u>Forest Service</u> closes these facilities during nesting season each year, only reopening the area once the offspring have fledged. [7]

The live-stream gained significant attention in 2023, when Jackie and Shadow attempted to hatch eggs despite <u>multiple atmospheric rivers</u> that brought 45 inches (1.1 m) of snow to the area. [3][8] As of February 2024, Jackie and Shadow have laid 14+ eggs together, five of which have hatched, with two or three of the eaglets surviving into adulthood. [9][10][11] [12]

In 2025, the pair successfully hatched three eggs. [13]
